Holes 7 thru 12 – 2-Person Alternate Shot (Both Players Drive, Choose 1 ball, then finish the hole with alternate shot)

Holes 13 thru 18 – 2-Person Scramble

Just a Few Reminders to Our Members to make our Job easier to serve you....

1. No Sun Flower Seeds allowed anywhere on the golf course.
2. You must be 16 years of age to rent a power cart at the Lac La Biche Golf Club. This will be strictly enforced so please bring your I.D.
3. If you own a Private Cart, unless we are out of power carts to rent, you are not allowed to lend your power cart out to guests.
4. Please don't ask to play in a five-some or six-some. Golf is meant to be played in foursomes. There is a time and a place to play with more than four people to a group but Saturday morning is not the time!
5. You must always check in to the Pro Shop before heading out.
6. We do not mind people beginning on hole #10 once in a while, HOWEVER, people coming from hole #9 DO HAVE THE RIGHT OF WAY when coming to hole #10.
7. If you are not keeping up with the group in front of you and there are people behind you waiting, PLEASE ALLOW THE GROUP BEHIND YOU TO PLAY THROUGH! No one wants to be waiting and no one wants to be pressured from behind so please allow the group behind you to play through.
8. The Lac La Biche Golf Club has developed a Dress Code for 2010. Males must have sleeves on their shirts. This means no muscle shirts or shirts with sleeves that are cut off at the shoulder are allowed on the golf course.
9. When we have you sign the Cart Rental Disclaimer and we put Cart #10 beside your name and give you Key #10, that means please take Cart #10! Just because Cart #8 is first in line doesn't mean take Cart #8. If you have Key #10, that mean Cart #10.
10. Pull Carts are NOT allowed on Tee Boxes or Fringes! Please walk around. Our course is in too great of a condition to have it damaged by pull carts.
11. If you see damage or something happening on the golf course that is not supposed to be going on, please report it to the Pro Shop. It is hard for Pro Shop Staff to rectify the problem if we do not know it is going on.
